As you can see, the new inpatient rooms are quite spacious. Each private room will include a closet, flat screen television, and miniature refrigerator.



Lena's Gift Shoppe will be relocated to the main entrance, across from the receptionist's desk.

Sitrin's former 80-bed unit is being renovated for inpatient medical rehabilitation. It will feature a comfortable, hotel-like atmosphere with 46 private rooms and bathrooms. The new unit will include a large dining area, wireless internet café, newly remodeled central bath area, and VIP rooms. Two rooms will be also be fitted with Environmental Control Units (ECUs) to assist individuals with ALS, Parkinson's Disease, or other clinically complex conditions. This technology will allow for greater independence by enabling individuals to control their surroundings and perform everyday tasks by themselves. Sitrin will also add ten larger beds to accommodate bariatric patients, and some rooms will also have electronic lift systems for individuals who need extra assistance.

Renovations to the new inpatient medical rehabilitation unit are expected to be complete this fall.
