



All of the wings for the Cedarbrook assisted living complex are built, windows are installed, and the roofing is complete! Sprinkler systems are being put into the buildings, and many of the showers have also been set. Workers will begin to put siding on the complex soon.



Insulation has been sprayed onto the underside of the roof in all four wings, and workers are framing and setting the trusses for the common area.



After the trusses were set and framed, the roof decking was applied, officially connecting all four wings.

Sitrin's expansion project is making great progress. In fact, there are approximately 50 people working on the site each day. According to Sitrin Construction Manager Dave Astafan, "The break in the weather has really made a difference. We have made more progress over the last few weeks than we did over two months of winter."

Northeast Construction Services, Inc. is the general contractor for both projects, and Fred Burrows Trucking & Excavating is the excavating contractor.
