### Do you experience any of the following symptoms?

- Muffled sounds or speech
- Difficulty understanding words, especially with background noise
- Asking others to repeat words or speak more slowly
- Ringing in your ears
- Constantly increasing volume on the radio or television
- Avoiding social gatherings
- Withdrawing from conversations
- Frequently nodding, but wondering what you're agreeing to

Hearing loss can also affect children. They can be born with hearing loss due to an infection, or they can acquire it from a genetic component, prematurity, or oxygen deprivation.
