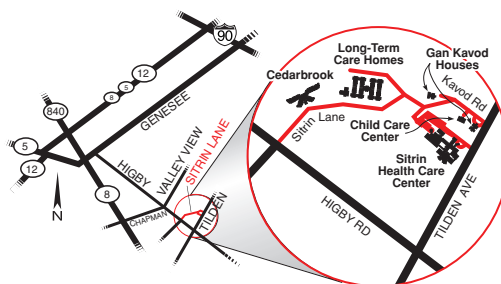

### Comprehensive Clinical Team

Each house has a Registered Nurse and Coordinator overseeing our residents' program and care plans. Our physician visits each house weekly, as does a dietician, occupational therapist, physical therapist, speech language pathologist and behavior specialist.

### Personalized Approach

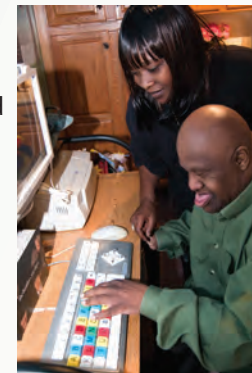
Our team works together with each resident to encourage them to participate to their fullest extent in decisions involving their medical, social, religious, and emotional needs.

### Active Community and Family Involvement

Our residents enjoy participating in many activities in our local and regional area, including regular shopping trips for home and personal items, wellness and aquatic programs, outings to the theatre, sporting and special events, dining and other activities. Family members are welcome at daily activities and special events.

### Enhanced Services for Dementia

Birch residence is equipped with a special system to enhance safety for individuals with dementia-like symptoms who have a tendency to wander. Each residence also has programs tailored to meet overall needs for persons with dementia.



### Day Program Choices

Sitrin collaborates with a variety of day program providers in our area to assure residents have access to the most appropriate day program choice. Integration with the general community is encouraged.
