Social Model

The OPAL Program's social model is available weekdays, and provides adults of all ages with the opportunity to take some time away from home. In the program, participants are able to partake in specialized activities, while mingling with peers. The program is designed to promote camaraderie and build friendships, while also providing unique outings and events.

Participants of the program can enjoy community outings, cooking workshops, live entertainment, theme celebrations, meals and snacks, and personal care assistance.

Eligibility: Participants can refer themselves to the program, or be referred by a family member, community case manager, or Medicaid provider.

Medical Model

The OPAL Program's medical model is available seven days a week, and is customized to meet the physical or cognitive needs of an individual. This model is specifically designed for persons who may require supervision, monitoring, or hands-on-care.

In addition to the program's social and recreational activities, participants in the medical model will receive medication administration, specialized therapy sessions, and licensed nursing services.

Eligibility: Participants require physician approval prior to enrollment, in order to individualize each person's needs. Participants must remain under the care of their primary physician throughout program enrollment.
